Supplies

5 inch squares needed for length desired, you can also make it scrappy with 2-1/2 inch squares

OR

7-8 inch square and jelly roll strips for length desired

½ yard batting & ½ yard backing (a little larger than desired length)

Pins, Scissors, coordinating thread & Walking Foot

Examples

Charm pack with Missouri Star layout



2-1/2 inch squares with pointed ends layout (96 2-1/2 inch squares sewn into 24 4-patches)



Tumbling blocks

Half square triangles (zig zag uses 2 triangles sewn together on the short side)



Jelly roll around a square of fabric



Instructions

- 1) Layout squares or strips in the desired layout keeping colors and patterns scattered. Sew together sewing all the way to the edge of the squares or strips.
- 2) Layer batting, backing right side up, and runner right side down and pin at each point.
- 3) Sew around the quilt with $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowance EXCEPT for a 4-6 inch opening to turn. Jenny trims hers before sewing, but I do not.
- 4) Clip curves and trim off points being careful not to clip stitch line. Leave a little extra at opening to make sure top stitching catches.
- 5) Turn and press. Then top stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ inch all the way around.
- 6) Quilt in the ditch. I have also done a cross hatch quilting or $\frac{1}{4}$ inch quilting. Use your creativity. You can also use decorative stitches as shown in the jelly roll runner.
- 7) Enjoy on your table or give as a gift to a friend! If you have a nice backing, it is reversible.
